HOUSE BILL 483

1 AN ACT WITH RESPECT TO STATE AND REGIONAL PLANNING.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:  
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5 **Section 1.** G.S. 143-337(b) is amended by striking from lines six and seven of that  
6 subsection the words "Long-Range" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "State and  
7 Regional".

8 **Sec. 2.** G.S. 143-341(6) is rewritten to read as follows:

9 "(6) State and regional planning:

- 10 a. To assist the Director of the Budget in reviewing the capital  
11 improvements needs and requests of all State agencies, and in  
12 preparing a coordinated biennial capital improvements budget and  
13 longer range capital improvements programs.
- 14 b. In cooperation with State agencies and other public and private  
15 agencies, to collect, analyze, and keep up to date a comprehensive  
16 collection of economic and social data pertinent to state planning,  
17 which shall be available to State and local governmental agencies  
18 and private agencies.
- 19 c. To coordinate and review all planning activity relative to Federal  
20 Government requirements for general state-wide or regional  
21 comprehensive program planning.
- 22 d. To make economic analyses, studies, and projections and to advise  
23 the Governor on courses of action desirable for the maintenance of a  
24 sound economy.
- 25 e. To encourage and assist in the development of the planning process  
26 within State and local governmental agencies.
- 27 f. To assist State agencies by providing them with basic information  
28 and technical assistance needed in preparing their short-range and  
29 long-range programs.
- 30 g. To develop and maintain liaison and cooperative arrangements with  
31 federal, interstate, state, and private agencies and organizations in the  
32 interest of obtaining information and assistance with respect to state  
33 and regional planning.
- 34 h. To develop and maintain a comprehensive plan for the development  
35 of the State, representing the coordinated efforts and contributions of  
36 all participating planning groups.
- 37 i. In cooperation with the counties, the cities and towns, the federal  
38 government, multi-state commissions and private agencies and  
39 organizations, to develop a system of multi-county, regional planning  
40 districts to cover the entire State, and to assist in preparing for those  
41 districts comprehensive development plans coordinated with the  
42 comprehensive development plan for the State."

43 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.

1                    **Sec. 4.** This Act shall become effective upon its ratification.  
2                    In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 30th day of June,  
3                    1969.
