A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PAY
3 THE NONBETTERMENT RELOCATION COSTS OF COUNTY WATER AND
4 SEWER LINES IN CONJUNCTION WITH HIGHWAY PROJECTS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 136-27.1. reads as rewritten:

7 **"§ 136-27.1. Relocation of water and sewer lines of municipalities and nonprofit**
8 **water or sewer corporations or associations.**

9 The Department of Transportation shall pay the nonbetterment cost for the
10 relocation of water and sewer lines, located within the existing State highway right-of-
11 way, that are necessary to be relocated for a State highway improvement project and
12 that are owned by: (i) a municipality with a population of 5,500 or less according
13 to the latest decennial census; (ii) a nonprofit water or sewer association or corporation;
14 or (iii) any water or sewer system organized pursuant to Chapter 162A or Chapter 153A
15 of the General Statutes."

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
