9 10	litter cases brought under G.S. 14-399, and to accept written appearances, waivers of trial and pleas of guilty in violations of G.S.
11	14-399 and enter judgments in those cases as the chief district judge
12	directs."
13	Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
