A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT TO CLARIFY A SHERIFF'S PERSONAL LIABILITY FOR THE ACTS OF
 HIS DEPUTY.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. A new section is added to Chapter 162 of the General Statutes to 6 read:

7 "§ 162.26. Responsibility for act of deputy.

- 8 The sheriff shall have personal liability for an act performed by his deputy only if 9 the act was:
- 10(1)Within the actual scope and course of the deputy's employment and in11furtherance of his authorized duties as a deputy; or
- 12(2)Performed at the direction or command of the sheriff or done in13accordance with the written policy of the Department; or
- 14(3)Performed with the sheriff's personal participation in the act or his15later ratification of such act.
- Provided, however, that the sheriff shall have no personal liability for an act of his deputy where such deputy was acting contrary to a direct order of the sheriff. Nothing herein shall limit the liability of the county for the negligence or the willful acts of employees of the county, including the sheriff and his deputies. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, this section shall not apply to actions for amercements
- 21 pursuant to law."
- 22 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
