1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TEMPORARY RULES OF THE 1989
2 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO PROVIDE DEADLINES FOR
3 INTRODUCTION AND PASSAGE OF BILLS.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 Section 1. Rule 31.1 of the Temporary Rules of the 1989 House of
6 Representatives reads as rewritten:

7 "RULE 31.1. Deadlines on Introduction and Receipt of Bills.

8 (a) ~~All local bills or bills prepared to be introduced for departments, agencies, or~~
9 ~~institutions of the State must be introduced not later than the third Thursday in April~~
10 ~~(April 16) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any local measure~~
11 ~~submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m.~~
12 ~~by the preceding Wednesday and filed in the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m.~~
13 ~~on the next Wednesday in April (April 22) shall be treated as if it had been filed for~~
14 ~~introduction pursuant to this subsection. All bills or resolutions recommended by~~
15 ~~commissions or committees authorized or directed by act or resolution of the General~~
16 ~~Assembly to report to the 1989 Regular Session of the General Assembly, or to report~~
17 ~~prior to convening of that session, must be introduced not later than the last Thursday in~~
18 ~~February (February 23) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any such~~
19 ~~measure submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by~~
20 ~~4:00 p.m. on that date and introduced in the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m.~~
21 ~~on the next Thursday (March 2) shall be treated as if it had been introduced pursuant to~~
22 ~~this subsection.~~

23 (a1) All bills prepared to be introduced for departments, agencies, or institutions
24 of the State must be introduced not later than the second Thursday in March (March 9)
25 of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any such measure submitted to the
26 Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. on that date and

1 introduced in the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday
2 (March 16) shall be treated as if it had been introduced pursuant to this subsection.

3 (a2) All local bills must be introduced not later than the third Thursday in March
4 (March 16) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any such measure
5 submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m.
6 on that date and introduced in the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m. on the next
7 Thursday (March 23) shall be treated as if it had been introduced pursuant to this
8 subsection.

9 ~~(b) All public bills except appropriations bills or adjournment resolutions must be~~
10 ~~introduced by April 30.~~ All public bills not containing appropriations or tax law changes
11 must be introduced not later than the last Thursday in March (March 30) of the first year
12 of the biennial session; provided that any such measure submitted to the Bill Drafting
13 Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m. on that date and introduced in
14 the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m. on the next Thursday (April 6) shall be
15 treated as if it had been introduced pursuant to this subsection.

16 ~~(c) All appropriations bills must be introduced by May 21.~~ All public bills
17 containing appropriations or tax law changes must be introduced not later than the last
18 Thursday in April (April 27) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any
19 such measure submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office
20 by 4:00 p.m. on that date and introduced in the House of Representatives before 3:00
21 p.m. on the next Thursday (May 4) shall be treated as if it had been introduced pursuant
22 to this subsection.

23 (c1) All resolutions, except those honoring the memory of deceased persons or
24 adjourning the General Assembly must be introduced not later than the first Thursday in
25 May (May 4) of the first year of the biennial session; provided that any such measure
26 submitted to the Bill Drafting Division of the Legislative Services Office by 4:00 p.m.
27 on that date and introduced in the House of Representatives before 3:00 p.m. on the next
28 Thursday (May 11) shall be treated as if it had been introduced pursuant to this
29 subsection.

30 (d) In order to be eligible for consideration by the House during the first regular
31 session, all Senate bills other than finance or appropriations bills or adjournment
32 resolutions, must be received and read on the floor of the House as a message from the
33 Senate no later than May 28~~11~~; provided that a message from the Senate received by the
34 next legislative day stating that a bill has passed its third reading and is being engrossed
35 shall comply with the requirements of this subsection and provided that the Senate has a
36 similar rule."
