A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE PERCENTAGE AREA LIMITATION ON  
VOLUNTARY SATELLITE ANNEXATIONS BY THE CITY OF  
STATESVILLE, AND TO MODIFY THAT LIMITATION AS TO THE TOWN  
OF WAKE FOREST.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) does not apply to the City of Statesville.

Sec. 2. (a) The provisions of G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) do not apply as to the  
Town of Wake Forest to any property:

(1) For which a request for municipal utility service has been received  
consistent with the Town's Land Use Management Plan; and

(2) Which is within the Wake Forest Perimunicipal Planning Area as  
shown on the map of Perimunicipal Planning Areas approved by Wake  
County.

(b) Except as provided by subsection (a) of this section, the provisions of Part 4  
of Article 4A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes shall continue to apply to the  
Town of Wake Forest.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
