3	Sec. 2. The seasons for hunting black bears in the areas of Gates County
4	described in Section 1 in 1991 and succeeding years shall be for at least six days, as
5	established by the Wildlife Resources Commission.
6	Sec. 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is a primitive
7	weapons season for hunting black bear in Gates County from the first Monday in
8	November to the following Saturday, and thereafter each year as established by the
9	Wildlife Resources Commission. For purposes of this act, "primitive weapons" shall
10	mean bow and arrow and flintlock firearms with open iron sights.
11	Sec. 4. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
