A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR APPOINTING AND
2 SUPERVISING THE CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER (FINANCE
3 DIRECTOR) OF THE CITY OF STATESVILLE FROM THE COUNCIL TO THE
4 MANAGER.
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6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Section 4.21 of the Charter of the City of Statesville, being
8 Chapter 289, Session Laws of 1977, reads as rewritten:

9 "Sec. 4.21. **City Clerk and Deputy City Clerk.** (a) The City ~~Council~~Manager
10 shall appoint a City Clerk and may appoint a Deputy City Clerk to keep a journal of the
11 proceedings of the Council, to maintain in a safe place all records and documents
12 pertaining to the affairs of the City, and to perform such other duties as may be required
13 by law or as the Council or City Manager may direct.

14 (b) The City Council may combine the position of the City Clerk with any other
15 office or offices that it sees fit, vesting in the person holding such combined office or
16 offices the powers and duties of all offices."

17 Sec. 2. Section 4.23 of the Charter of the City of Statesville, being Chapter
18 289, Session Laws of 1977, reads as rewritten:

19 "Sec. 4.23. **City Treasurer.** (a) The City ~~Council~~Manager shall appoint a
20 Treasurer and may appoint a Deputy Treasurer to perform the duties of the finance
21 officer as required by the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act, and to
22 perform such other duties as the ~~Council~~City Manager may direct.

1 (b) The City Council may combine the position of the City Treasurer with any
2 other office or offices that it sees fit, vesting in the person holding such combined office
3 or offices the powers and duties of all offices."

4 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
