## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW CAPITAL AREA VISITOR 3 CENTER.
- Whereas, the Capital Area Visitor Center serves the State of North Carolina 4 as an information center and schedules tours for groups to visit the government complex 5 and other local sites; and 6
- 7 Whereas, the Visitor Center provides initial orientation and interpretation for 8 the State Capitol and the Executive Mansion; and
- 9 Whereas, the Visitor Center was established in 1976 and has grown to over 100,000 visitors annually, with the majority of these visitors school children; and 10
- Whereas, the present facilities have not been updated since 1976 and are 11 inadequate to meet the increasing number if visitors; Now, therefore, 12
- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 13

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 14 Administration the sum of \$136,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for advance plans to be 15 developed for a new visitor center and two layers of underground parking to be located 16 on the site specified by the North Carolina Planning Commission in its master plan for 17 18 the State Government Center. 19

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
