2 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH 3 COMMISSION TO STUDY METHODS OF INCREASING INVOLVEMENT OF TEACHERS AND PARENTS IN DEVELOPING SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT 4 5 THE PERFORMANCE-BASED ACCOUNTABILITY PLANS UNDER PROGRAM AND OF INCREASING THE INVOLVEMENT OF TEACHERS IN 6 7 APPROVING SUCH PLANS.

8 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

9 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study methods of increasing involvement of parents and teachers in developing local school improvement 10 plans under the Performance-based Accountability Program and of increasing the 11 12 involvement of teachers in approving such plans. Specifically, the study may include the provisions of Section 1 of House Bill 2367, as introduced on June 6, 1990, which 13 provided (a) for the involvement of over fifty percent (50%) of the teachers in a local 14 school administrative unit in developing the unit's local school improvement plan, for 15 (b) a vote by teachers in each individual school for approving the strategies for that 16 17 school for attaining the local student performance goals, and (c) for a vote by teachers and administrators before submission of a local school improvement plan to the State 18 Superintendent for approval. The study may also include consideration of methods of 19 20 involvement of substantial numbers of parents in developing the unit's local school 21 improvement plan.

22 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make a final report to the 23 1991 General Assembly by February 1, 1991.
