- 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF NEGLECTED CHILD WITHIN THE 3
 - JUVENILE JURISDICTION OF THE DISTRICT COURT.
- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 5
 - Section 1. G.S. 7A-517(21) reads as rewritten:

"(21) Neglected Juvenile. – A juvenile who does not receive proper care, 6 supervision, or discipline from his parent, guardian, custodian, or caretaker; or who has 7 been abandoned; or who is not provided necessary medical care or other remedial care 8 recognized under State law, or who lives in an environment injurious to his welfare, or 9 who lives in a home where another child dies and there is probable cause to believe the 10 child died as a result of abuse or neglect or who lives in a home where another child has 11 been subjected to sexual abuse or severe physical abuse within the family, or who has 12 been placed for care or adoption in violation of law." 13

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989. 14
