

- 1 On each side, two side marker lamps, one at or near the front
2 and one at or near the rear.
- 3 On each side, two reflectors, one at or near the front and one at
4 or near the rear.
- 5 On the rear, two clearance lamps, one at each side, also two
6 reflectors, one at each side, and one stoplight.
- 7 (5) On every pole trailer having a gross weight of 4,000 pounds or more:
8 On each side, one side marker lamp and one clearance lamp
9 which may be in combination, to show to the front, side and
10 rear.
11 On the rear of the pole trailer or load, two reflectors, one at each
12 side.
- 13 (6) On every trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer having a gross weight of
14 less than 4,000 pounds:
15 On the rear, two reflectors, one on each side. If any trailer or
16 semitrailer is so loaded or is of such dimensions as to obscure
17 the stoplight on the towing vehicle, then such vehicle shall also
18 be equipped with one stoplight.
- 19 (7) Front clearance lamps and those marker lamps and reflectors mounted
20 on the front or on the side near the front of a vehicle shall display or
21 reflect an amber color.
- 22 (8) Rear clearance lamps and those marker lamps and reflectors mounted
23 on the rear or on the sides near the rear of a vehicle shall display or
24 reflect a red color.
- 25 (9) Brake lights (and/or brake reflectors) on the rear of a motor vehicle
26 shall be red. The light illuminating the license plate shall be white. All
27 other lights shall be white, amber, yellow, clear or red.
- 28 (10) On every trailer and semitrailer which is 30 feet or more in length and
29 has a gross vehicle weight of 4,000 pounds or more, a side-marker
30 lamp and reflector or one-a combination marker lamp showing amber
31 and mounted on the bottom side rail at or near the center of each side of the
32 trailer and reflector that meet the requirements of 49 C.F.R. Part 393,
33 Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.”
