8	methamphetamine shall be guilty of a felony which felony shall be									
9	known as 'trafficking in methamphetamine' and if the quantity of

11	<u>a.</u>	Is 15 grams or more, but less than 100 grams, such person shall								
12		be punished as a Class F felon and shall be sentenced to a term								
13		of at least six years in the State's prison and shall be fined not								
14		less than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000);								
15	b. Is 100 grams or more, but less than 300 grams, such personal									
16		shall be punished as a Class D felon and shall be sentenced to a								
17		term of at least 12 years in the State's prison and shall be fined								
18		not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000);								
19	<u>C.</u>	Is 300 grams or more, such person shall be punished as a Class
