- 1 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Commerce for fiscal year 1989-90 the sum of \$25,000 for the purpose of funding the 3 creation and operation of the North Carolina Travel and Tourism Commission.
- 4 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
