A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL
2 AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY FOR ITS CENTENNIAL
3 CELEBRATION.

5 Whereas, North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University was
6 founded in 1891 and is approaching the 100th anniversary of its founding; and

7 Whereas, a committee has been formed to plan North Carolina A & T State
8 University's Centennial Celebration and has chosen the theme, "Celebration and
9 Challenge; A Second Century"; and

10 Whereas, as the theme suggests, it is the committee's goal to celebrate the
11 university's first 100 years of progress and to focus on events and persons who played
12 significant roles in advancing the university; and

13 Whereas, it is the committee's objective to plan a celebration that will bring
14 together the entire university and its many supporters to partake in activities which will
15 dramatize the university's rich tradition and service; and

16 Whereas, North Carolina A & T State University's Centennial Celebration
17 will alert the public to the university's present aim and its need for support; and

18 Whereas, North Carolina A & T State University's Centennial Celebration
19 will examine the past and present achievements of the university in hopes of building a
20 foundation upon which philosophical and operational directions for the future may be
21 built; and

22 Whereas, funds are needed to carry out North Carolina A & T State
23 University's Centennial Celebration; Now, therefore,

1 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
3 Governors of The University of North Carolina for North Carolina Agricultural and
4 Technical State University the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
5 1989-90 fiscal year to help fund the university's centennial observance.

6 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
