CHAPTER 189
HOUSE BILL 504

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE LAWS CODIFIED AS ARTICLE 7A OF CHAPTER 143 AND ARTICLE 6 OF CHAPTER 143B OF THE GENERAL STATUTES ALLOWING THE SECRETARIES OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND CORRECTION TO ADOPT RULES ON DAMAGE OR THEFT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, AND CLIENTS IN INSTITUTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENTS OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND CORRECTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 393 of the 1985 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 264, Session Laws of 1987, is amended by deleting "This act shall expire July 1, 1989."

Sec. 2. Section 3 of Chapter 639 of the 1987 Session Laws is amended by deleting "This act shall expire July 1, 1989."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 1st day of June, 1989.
