Section 1. G.S. 105-113.75 reads as rewritten:

Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-500(a) reads as rewritten:

- "(a) Appointment. The Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety shall appoint alcohol law-enforcement agents and other enforcement personnel. The Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety may also appoint regular employees of the Commission as alcohol law-enforcement agents. Beginning July 1, 1989, and annually thereafter, each alcohol law enforcement agent shall be granted a salary increase in an amount corresponding to the increments between steps within the salary range established for the class to which the agent's position is assigned by the State Personnel Commission, not to exceed the maximum of each applicable salary range. Beginning July 1, 1989, and annually thereafter, alcohol law enforcement agents shall be provided an annual clothing allowance of four hundred dollars (\$400.00)."
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of one million nine hundred fifty-two thousand three hundred and twenty-one dollars (\$1,952,321) for the fiscal year 1989-90 and the sum of one million two hundred seventy thousand one hundred sixty-three dollars (\$1,270,163) for the fiscal year 1990-91 to fund salaries, benefits, and equipment for 36 new Alcohol Law Enforcement agents and one Secretary IV to be added in fiscal year 1989-90.
- Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of one hundred thirty thousand six hundred twelve dollars (\$130,612) for the fiscal year 1989-90 and the sum of two hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred forty dollars (\$291,940) for the fiscal year 1990-91 to fund the annual pay increase of Alcohol Law Enforcement agents provided by G.S. 18B-500(a) as amended by Section 2 of this act.
- Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of fifty-five thousand two hundred dollars (\$55,200) for the fiscal year 1989-90 and the sum of fifty-five thousand two hundred dollars (\$55,200) for the fiscal year 1990-91 to fund an annual clothing allowance for Alcohol Law Enforcement agents as provided by G.S. 18B-500(a) as amended by Section 2 of this act.
  - Sec. 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
