A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE GATES COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MODIFY THE WASTEWATER SYSTEM AT THE GATES COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL.

Whereas, all Gates County Schools are presently in violation of Environmental Protection Agency Wastewater Regulations; and

Whereas, the Division of Environmental Management requires that Gates County School wastewater systems be brought into compliance in a reasonable period of time; and

Whereas, the average cost of modifying each of the six county school wastewater systems will be three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000); and

Whereas, the Gates County Schools have funding needs beyond anticipated revenues to expand facilities to meet the requirements of the Basic Education Program;

Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Gates County Board of Education the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to bring the Gates County High School's wastewater system into compliance with State and federal wastewater regulations.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
