- AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF TRAVEL AND 2
- 3 TOURISM FOR A TOURISM MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 5 Commerce, Division of Travel and Tourism, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars 6 7 (\$500,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the tourism matching grant program.
- The Department of Commerce may not grant more than ten thousand dollars 8 (\$10,000) to any one grantee during a fiscal year to promote tourism. No grantee may 9 receive a grant in three consecutive fiscal years. All grants by the Department of 10 Commerce to promote tourism shall be made on condition that the grantee match the 11 grant on a dollar-for-dollar basis. Grants to promote tourism may not be used for the 12 13 following purposes:
