CHAPTER 474
HOUSE BILL 762

AN ACT TO ALLOW SAMPSON COUNTY TO ESTABLISH VOTING
PRECINCTS WITHOUT REGARD TO TOWNSHIP BOUNDARIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 163-128, a county board of elections may divide a county into precincts, for the purpose of voting, without regard to township boundaries.

Sec. 2. This act applies to Sampson County only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of June, 1989.
