## CHAPTER 229 HOUSE BILL 796

## AN ACT TO ESTABLISH FOX SEASONS IN HYDE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is a season for taking, hunting, or killing foxes with bow and arrow, rifle, shotgun, and dogs from November 15 through January 1 of each year.
- Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is a season for taking, hunting, or killing foxes with traps from January 2 through the last day of February of each year.
- Sec. 3. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.
- Sec. 4. A season bag limit of 20 applies in the aggregate to all foxes taken during the fox seasons established in this act.
- Sec. 5. Section 2 of Chapter 932 of the 1951 Session Laws is rewritten to read: "This act shall not apply to the hunting of game birds or foxes."
  - Sec. 6. This act shall apply only to Hyde County.
  - Sec. 7. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 5th day of June, 1989.
