- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
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Section 1. G.S. 126-2(b) reads as rewritten:

6 The Commission shall consist of seven members who shall be "(b) appointed by the Governor on July 1, 1965, or as soon thereafter as is practicable. Two 7 members of the Commission shall be chosen from employees of the State ject-subject to 8 the provisions of this Chapter; two-four members shall be appointed appointed, of which 9 two shall be employees of local government who are subject to the provisions of this 10 Chapter, from a list of individuals nominated by the North Carolina association of 11 county commissioners; two members shall be individuals actively engaged in the 12 management of a private business or industry; and one member shall be appointed from 13 the public at large. Of the initial members of the Commission, two shall be appointed to 14 15 serve for terms of two years, two shall be appointed to serve for terms of four years, and three shall be appointed to serve for terms of six years. Of the two members added to 16 the Commission in 1989, one shall be appointed to serve for a term of four years and 17 one shall be appointed to serve for a term of six years. Their successors Successors shall 18 be appointed by the Governor for terms of six years. Any vacancy occurring prior to 19 the expiration of a term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term." 20 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989, and provides for the 21

22 appointment of two additional members, as authorized in Section 1 of this act, on or 23 after that date.

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
