- 3 PREMISES MALT BEVERAGE LICENSES.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 105-113.71(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Local Exceptions. – The governing bodies of the following counties and cities
7 in their discretion may decline to issue on-premises unfortified wine <u>and on-premises</u>
8 <u>malt beverage</u> licenses: the Counties of Alamance, Alexander, Ashe, Avery, Chatham,
9 Clay, Duplin, Granville, Greene, Haywood, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell,
10 Montgomery, Nash, Pender, Randolph, Robeson, Sampson, Transylvania, Vance,
11 Watauga, Wilkes, Yadkin; any city within any of those counties; and the Cities of
12 Greensboro, Aulander, Pink Hill, and Zebulon."

13 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
