A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION IN IREDELL
2 COUNTY TO PERMIT THE TRANSFER OF STUDENTS FROM ONE SCHOOL
3 ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT TO ANOTHER WITHIN THE COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The local boards of education in Iredell county shall permit the
7 transfer of a student from one local school administrative unit to another local school
8 administrative unit within the county, regardless of whether the student is domiciled
9 within the attendance boundaries of the administrative unit to which the student is
10 requesting transfer, when such transfer is requested, in writing, by the parent or
11 guardian of the student, or by a person standing **in loco parentis** to the student.
12 Requests for transfer shall be made to the school boards of the local school
13 administrative units involved in the requested transfer at least 60 days prior to the
14 requested effective date of the transfer and shall set forth reasons for the transfer
15 request.

16 Requests for transfer may not be denied except upon a finding by the school
17 boards of the local school administrative units involved in the transfer, based upon
18 substantial evidence, that the transfer would be detrimental to the interests of the
19 student, or that the transfer would violate State or federal law or federal court order.

20 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification, applies only to school boards
21 and local school administrative units in Iredell county, and applies to all school years
22 beginning with the 1989-90 school year.
