A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF
2 SUGAR MOUNTAIN TO DETERMINE WHETHER MIXED BEVERAGES
3 MAY BE SOLD IN THAT VILLAGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 6, Chapter 18B, of the
7 General Statutes, the Village Council of Sugar Mountain may call an election on the
8 sale of mixed beverages. The ballot propositions shall be those stated in G.S. 18B-
9 602(h). If the sale of mixed beverages is approved, purchase-transportation permits shall
10 be issued and sales of liquor shall be made by the Banner Elk ABC system.

11 Sec. 2. All of the provisions of Chapter 18B of the General Statutes not
12 inconsistent with Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall apply.

13 Sec. 3. This act shall apply to Avery County only.

14 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
