S 1 SENATE BILL 1423 Short Title: Hope Mills Lake and Park Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Tally; and Raynor. Referred to: Appropriations. May 30, 1990 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF HOPE MILLS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PAVILION AT ITS LAKE AND PARK AREA. Whereas, the Town of Hope Mills' Lake and Park area serves a population of approximately 30,000 people; and Whereas, the Lake and Park Area has become a tourist area, at times attracting up to 10,000 people; and Whereas, the present concession building on the grounds of the Lake and Park area no longer meets the needs of the public; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Hope Mills the sum of \$50,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for construction of an open pavilion to enhance its Lake and Park area and to provide adequate accommodations for the general public.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
