AN ACT TO REQUIRE HOTELS AND MOTELS TO POST TELEPHONE
SURCHARGES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Chapter 72 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:
"§ 72-6.1. Posting telephone surcharges by hotels and motels.
(a) Every hotel, motel, or innkeeper that imposes any surcharge for local,
collect, credit card, toll-free, or long distance calls shall post a notice that a surcharge
will be made by conspicuous sign located at or near the principal telephone in each
guest room so as to be easily seen by its patrons.
(b) A violation of subsection (a) of this section is an infraction."
Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
