A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ATHLETIC FIELD HOUSE FOR3 NORTHSIDE HIGH SCHOOL IN BEAUFORT COUNTY.
- Whereas, the new Northside High School in Beaufort County will serve the high school students from Bath High School in Bath, John A. Wilkinson High School in Belhaven, Pantego Junior High School in Pantego, and Pinetown Elementary School in Pinetown; and
- 8 Whereas, over the last few years, Bath High School, John A. Wilkinson High 9 School, and Pantego High School have won a State championship in either football or 10 basketball; and
- 11 Whereas, there are no athletic facilities in the new Northside High School 12 except for a gym now under construction; and
- Whereas, Northside High School needs athletic equipment of all kinds and facilities, including lights, bleachers, field grading, a track, a baseball field, tennis courts, and a field house; Now, therefore,
- 16 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 17 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Beaufort 18 County Board of Education the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1989-90 19 fiscal year to be used to build a field house at Northside High School for athletic 20 activities.
