Section 3.3 of the Charter of the Town of Cajah Mountain, being 6 Chapter 52, Session Laws of 1983, reads as rewritten: 7 "Sec. 3.3. Term of office of aldermen. Five aldermen are to be elected at the first 8 regular Town election in November of 1983. The three persons who receive the highest 9 number of votes shall serve a four-year term, and the two persons receiving the next 10 highest number of votes shall serve a two-year term. The terms will continue to be 11

staggered, with ensuing aldermen being elected for four-year terms. No aldermen shall
