- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 44A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 7 section to read:

"§ 44A-35. Attorney's fees. 8

In any suit brought or defended under the provisions of Article 2 or Article 3 of 9 this Chapter, the presiding judge may allow a reasonable attorney's fee to the attorney 10 representing the prevailing party. This attorney's fee is to be taxed as part of the court 11 costs and be pavable by the losing party upon a finding that there was an unwarranted 12 refusal by the losing party to fully resolve the matter which constituted the basis of the 13 suit or the basis of the defense." 14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to actions filed 15

16 on or after that date.

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
