Section 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read "(33) Local boards of education shall adopt rules requiring that student report of	
be signed by the parent or guardian of or a person acting in loco parentis to the student	
For purposes of this section, the term 'report card' means a student academi	
behavioral report card, an end-of-grading period progress report, or an interim acade	
progress report issued at the mid point of a grading period. The rules concerning re	
cards shall include the following: (i) parents shall be notified in writing that	_
signature on the report card is required and that by signing the card a parent affirms	
he has reviewed the contents of the report card; and (ii) any student who signs the re-	-
card in the name of his parent, guardian, or person standing in loco parentis sha	
issued an out-of-school suspension of three days during the school year for the	
offense, and an out-of-school suspension of 10 days during the school year for	the the
second and each subsequent offense."	
Sec. 2. G.S. 115C-285 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d) The principal shall ensure that student report cards are signed by	each
student's parent or guardian, or person standing in loco parentis to the student, purs	

to rules adopted by the local board of education as prescribed by G.S. 115C-47(33)."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to all school years beginning with school year 1989-90.
