5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
7	section to read:
8	" <u>§ 136-102A. Scenic Highway and Memorial Highway.</u>
9	(a) All of Interstate Highway 40 wherever located in North Carolina shall be
10	known and designated as 'Scenic Highway and Memorial Highway.'
11	(b) The Department of Transportation shall use the procedures provided in
12	Article 10 of this Chapter to maintain and improve the natural scenic beauty of areas
13	traversed by this highway.
14	(c) No new outdoor advertising devices, except as permitted in subsection (d) of
15	this section, shall be constructed or placed so that they are visible or intended to be read
16	from the right-of-way of this highway.
17	(d) The Department of Transportation shall not issue any permits pursuant to
18	G.S. 136-133 for outdoor advertising devices within 660 feet of the nearest edge of the
19	right-of-way of this highway or for outdoor advertising devices beyond 660 feet of the
20	nearest edge of the right-of-way outside of urban areas that are designed to be visible
21	and intended to be read from the main-traveled way except for directional and other
22	official signs and notices as described in G.S. 136-129(1) and G.S. 136-129.1(1)."
