2	AN ACT TO ALLOW LESSORS AND RENTERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO
3	ELECT TO PAY HIGHWAY USE TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES OWNED ON
4	OCTOBER 1, 1989, AND TO CLARIFY THAT THESE MOTOR VEHICLES
5	ARE OTHERWISE SUBJECT TO THE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. Article 5A of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by
8	adding a new section to read:
9	"§ 105-187.11. Transition from sales tax to highway use tax for lessors and renters
10	<u>of motor vehicles.</u>
11	A tax at the rate set in G.S. 105-187.5(b) is levied on the gross receipts derived
12	by a retailer from the lease or rental of a motor vehicle owned by the retailer before
13	October 1, 1989, and leased or rented on or after that date. A retailer subject to this tax
14	may elect to pay highway use tax at the rate set in G.S. 105-187.3(a) on a motor vehicle
15	owned by the retailer before October 1, 1989, and leased or rented on or after that date.
16	The retail value of a motor vehicle for which a retailer makes an election under this
17	section is the value of the motor vehicle that would apply under G.S. 105-187.3(b) if the
18	retailer received the vehicle because of a reason other than the sale of the motor vehicle
19	on the date the retailer makes the election.
20	To make the election allowed by this section, a retailer shall complete a form
21	provided by the Division, pay the tax due, and pay the fee set in G.S. 20-85(a)(9). A
22	retailer who makes this election may not receive credit for any tax paid on the motor
23	vehicle under Article 5 of this Chapter or for any tax on gross receipts paid under this

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- Article. The Division shall notify the Secretary of Revenue of a retailer who makes an election under this section. Notwithstanding G.S. 105-187.9, the taxes collected under 2 this section shall be credited to the General Fund." 3
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 4
