2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT,			
3	HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES PREPARE A WATER RESOURCES			
4	DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS PLAN AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE			
5	DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET REVIEW THE PLAN AND ADOPT A WATER			
6	RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.			
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
8	Section 1. Article 21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by			
9	adding a new Part to read:			
10	"PART 8A. WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.			
11	" <u>§ 143-215.73A. Water Resources Development Program.</u>			
12	(a) <u>Program adopted.</u> - Before July 1, in each calendar year, the Department of			
13	Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall prepare a statewide plan for water			
14	resources development projects for a period of six years into the future. The plan shall			
15	be known as the Water Resources Development Program. The Department shall submit			
16	the plan to the Director of the Budget for review. If the plan differs from the program			
17	adopted for the preceding calendar year, the Department shall indicate what the changes			
18	are and shall state the reasons for those modifications. The Director of the Budget may			
19	modify the plan, but shall adopt a Water Resources Development Program by October 1			
20	<u>of each calendar year.</u>			
21	(b) Projects listed The plan shall list the following:			
22	(1) As of May 1, those water resources development projects approved by			
23	Congress.

13	assign a priority to each project listed under subsection (b) either by giving the project a

15	Department shall state its reasons for recommending the funding, deferral, or			
16	elimination of a project.			
17	The De	epartm	ent shall determine the priority of a project based on the following	
18	criteria: lo	ocal in	terest in the project, the cost of the project to the State, the benefit of	
19			State, and the environmental impact of the project.
