5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Geographical information systems databases and data files 6 Section 1. developed and operated by counties and cities are public records within the meaning of 7 Chapter 132 of the General Statutes. The county or city shall provide public access to 8 such systems by public access terminals and other output devices. Upon request, the 9 county or city shall furnish copies, in documentary or electronic form, to anyone 10 requesting them at reasonable cost. As a condition of furnishing an electronic copy, 11 whether on magnetic tape, magnetic disk, compact disk, or photo-optical device, a 12 county or city may require that the person obtaining the copy agree in writing that the 13 copy will not be resold or otherwise used for trade or commercial purposes. For 14 purposes of this section, publication or broadcast by the news media shall not constitute 15 a resale or use of the data for trade or commercial purposes. 16

- 17 Sec. 2. This act applies to <u>Brunswick</u>, Catawba, and Lincoln Counties and 18 the Cities of Conover, Hickory, Lincolnton, and Newton only.
- 19 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
