A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO EXTEND, BY A MONTH, THE LIFE OF THE LEGISLATIVE
3	RESEARCH COMMISSION DUE TO THE CHANGE IN THE CONVENING
4	DATE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, TO ALLOW THE LEGISLATIVE
5	RESEARCH COMMISSION'S PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO
6	COMPLETE ITS WORK, AND TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
7	LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION.
8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	Section 1. G.S. 120-30.11 reads as rewritten:
10	"§ 120-30.11. Time of appointments; terms of office.
11	Appointments to the Legislative Research Commission shall be made not earlier
12	than the close of each regular session of the General Assembly held in the odd-
13	numbered year nor later than 15 days subsequent to the close. The term of office shall
14	begin on the day of appointment, and shall end on December 15 of the next even-numbered
15	year. Except for the work of the Administrative Rules Review Committee, no-January 15 of
16	the next odd-numbered year. No moneys appropriated to the Legislative Research
17	Commission may be expended for meetings of the Commission, its committees or
18	subcommittees held after December 15 of the next even- numbered year-January 15 of the
19	next odd-numbered year and before the appointment of the next Legislative Research
20	Commission."
21	Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 6B of Chapter 120 of the
22	General Statutes and for the sole purpose of its advising the Legislative Services
23	Commission on the conduct of the State government performance audit study directed

by Section 347 of Chapter 689 of the 1991 Session Laws (Regular Session, 1991):

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GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

1	(1)	The existence of the Legislative Research Commission's Committee on	
2		the State Government Performance Audit shall continue until March	
3		31, 1993, when it shall terminate;	
4	(2)	Monies may be expended for the work and meetings of the Committee	
5		in reviewing and advising on the implementation and review of the	
6		State government performance audit until March 31, 1993;	
7	(3)	The present membership of the Committee shall continue in existence	
8		until that date; and	
9	(4)	Vacancies in the membership of the Committee shall be filled by the	
10		original appointing authority.	
11	Sec.	3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative	
12	Research Commission for the 1992-93 fiscal year the sum of twenty-five thousand		
13	dollars (\$25,000) to conduct its studies.	
14	Sec. 4	. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
