Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 7 section to read: "§ 14-32.3. Felonious assault with intent to kill or inflict extremely serious injury 8 or inflicting extremely serious injury; punishment. 9 For purposes of this section, extremely serious injury means injury resulting 10 (a) 11 in: Permanent physical or mental handicap or disability to another person; 12 (1) 13 14 Protracted hospitalization of another person. (2) Any person who assaults another person and inflicts extremely serious injury 15 (b) shall be punished as a Class H felon. 16 Any person who assaults another person with intent to kill or intent to inflict 17 extremely serious injury and who inflicts serious injury shall be punished as a Class H 18 19 felon."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to offenses
