G.S. 130A-144(e) reads as rewritten: The local health director shall ensure that control measures prescribed by the 5 Commission have been given to prevent the spread of all reportable communicable diseases or communicable conditions and any other communicable disease or communicable condition that represents a significant threat to the public health. The local health department shall provide, at no cost to the patient, the examination and 9 treatment for tuberculosis disease and infection and for sexually transmitted diseases 10 designated by the Commission." Sec. 2. G.S. 130A-160 through G.S. 130A-178 are repealed. 12

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective February 1, 1992.

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
