A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN TRUCKS REQUIRED TO BE INSPECTED
2 UNDER FEDERAL REGULATIONS FROM HAVING TO ALSO BE
3 INSPECTED UNDER THE STATE INSPECTION PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 20-183.2(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) Every motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer not including trailers
8 of a gross weight of less than 4,000 pounds and house ~~trailers, trailers and not including~~
9 commercial motor vehicles as defined in Parts 383.3, 390.5, and 391.85 of the Federal
10 Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, registered or required to be registered in North
11 Carolina when operated on the streets and highways of this State must display a current
12 approved inspection certificate at such place on the vehicle as may be designated by the
13 Commissioner, indicating that it has been inspected in accordance with this Part. Such
14 motor vehicle shall thereafter be inspected and display a current inspection certificate as
15 is required by subsection (b) hereof."

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
