2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY ELIGIBILITY FOR SALARY CONTINUATION BENEFITS  
3 FOR CERTAIN STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 143-166.13(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) The following persons who are subject to the Criminal Justice Training and  
7 Standards Act are entitled to benefits under this Article:

- 8 (1) State Government Security Officers, Department of Administration;
- 9 (2) State Correctional Officers, Department of Corrections;
- 10 (3) State Probation and Parole Officers, Department of Corrections;
- 11 (4) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,  
12 Department of Corrections;
- 13 (5) Alcohol Law-Enforcement Agents, Department of Crime Control and  
14 Public Safety;
- 15 (6) State Highway Patrol Officers, Department of Crime Control and  
16 Public Safety;
- 17 (7) State Legislative Building Special Police, General Assembly;
- 18 (8) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,  
19 Department of Human Resources;
- 20 (9) Youth Correctional Officers, Department of Human Resources;
- 21 (10) Insurance Investigators, Department of Insurance;
- 22 (11) State Bureau of Investigation Officers and Agents, Department of  
23 Justice;

- 1           (12) ~~Director and Assistant Director, License and Theft Enforcement~~  
2           ~~Section, Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of Transportation;~~  
3           ~~Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,~~
