A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH  
2 CAROLINA TO COORDINATE AND EXPAND EFFORTS IN RESEARCH,  
3 TEACHING, AND EXTENSION IN GERONTOLOGY.

5 Whereas, older citizens contribute significantly to the progress and general  
6 well-being of our State and nation; and

7 Whereas, The University of North Carolina presently carries out valuable  
8 research, teaching, and extension activities in gerontology and related fields; and

9 Whereas, The University of North Carolina needs to coordinate and expand  
10 its efforts in research, teaching, and extension in gerontology; Now, therefore,

11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
13 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of \$100,000 for the 1991-92  
14 fiscal year and the sum of \$100,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to provide funds to  
15 create the position of Gerontology Coordinator in the General Services Administration.

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
