1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE  
3 RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF  
4 REPRESENTATIVES OR THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE.

5           Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain  
6 appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of  
7 Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

8           Whereas, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro  
9 Tempore of the Senate have made recommendations; Now, therefore,  
10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11                                   **PART I. APPOINTMENTS OF THE SPEAKER**

12           Section 1. Thomas E. Terrell, Jr. of Guilford County is appointed to the  
13 Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Teachers' and State Employees' Comprehensive  
14 Major Medical Plan for a term to expire on June 30, 1993.

15           Sec. 2. Betty B. Adams of Wake County and Ivie Clayton of Wake County  
16 are appointed to the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art, each for a  
17 term to expire on June 30, 1993.

18           Sec. 3. Mark Donaldson of Chatham County is appointed to the Crime  
19 Victims Compensation Commission for a term to expire on June 30, 1995.

20           Sec. 4. Dr. Jack Levy of New Hanover County and Catherine Cameron of  
21 Chatham County are appointed to the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management  
22 Commission, each for a term to expire on June 30, 1993.

1           Sec. 5. Lynn R. McCaskill of Richmond County and Carolyn Allen of  
2 Guilford County are appointed to the North Carolina Low-Level Radioactive Waste  
3 Management Authority, each for a term to expire on June 30, 1995.

4           Sec. 6. Dr. William T. Fletcher of Durham County is appointed to the North  
5 Carolina Board of Science and Technology for a term to expire on June 30, 1993.

6           Sec. 7. Bo Rader of Lee County is appointed to the North Carolina Petroleum  
7 Underground Storage Tank Funds Council for a term to expire on June 30, 1993. This  
8 is the categorical appointment for an owner or operator of a convenience store that  
9 markets petroleum products.

10          Sec. 7.1. Louis Brandon of Guilford County is appointed to the Governor's  
11 Waste Management Board for a term to expire on June 30, 1993.

12          Sec. 7.2. Representative Ronald Smith of Carteret County and  
13 Representative Judy Hunt of Watauga County are appointed to the North Carolina  
14 Travel and Tourism Board, each for a term to expire on December 31, 1992. Victoria  
15 Sutton of Gaston County is appointed to the North Carolina Travel and Tourism Board  
16 for a term to expire on December 31, 1992. This is the categorical appointment for a  
17 person associated with tourism attractions in North Carolina.

18          Sec. 7.3. Section 18 of Chapter 714 of the 1991 Session Laws is amended by  
19 deleting the word "Rowan" and substituting the word "Davidson".

20          Sec. 7.4. Section 20 of Chapter 714 of the 1991 Session Laws is amended by  
21 deleting the phrase "C." and substituting the phrase "G.".

## 22           **PART II. APPOINTMENTS OF PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE**

23          Sec. 8. Henry Faircloth of Sampson County is appointed to the Real Estate  
24 Appraisal Board for a term to expire on June 30, 1994.

25          Sec. 9. Dorothy Kilpatrick of Henderson County is appointed to the North  
26 Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Commission for a term to expire on June 30,  
27 1993.

28          Sec. 10. Caroline C. Parker of Wayne County is appointed to the Board of  
29 Directors of the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Capital Projects Financing  
30 Agency for a term to expire on June 30, 1993.

31          Sec. 11. Don Ward of Wake County is appointed to the North Carolina  
32 Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Funds Council for a term to expire June 30,  
33 1993. This is the categorical appointment for a representative of an organization of  
34 petroleum marketers. Angela Waldorf of Wake County is appointed to the North  
35 Carolina Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Funds Council for a term to expire on  
36 June 30, 1993. This is the categorical appointment for a representative of an  
37 organization of refining companies. Thomas C. Mehder of Mecklenburg County is  
38 appointed to the North Carolina Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Funds Council  
39 for a term to expire on June 30, 1993. This is the categorical appointment for a  
40 representative of the environmental insurance industry. James Fain of Wake County is  
41 appointed to the North Carolina Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Funds Council  
42 for a term to expire on June 30, 1993, as the categorical appointment of a representative  
43 of the commercial lending institution industry.

1           Sec. 12. Judy Seamon of Carteret County is appointed to the North Carolina  
2 Center for Nursing Board of Directors for a term to expire on June 30, 1994. This is the  
3 categorical appointment for a nurse. Terry Rose of Wake County is appointed to the  
4 North Carolina Center for Nursing Board of Directors for a term to expire on June 30,  
5 1994. Betty Woodard of Guilford County is appointed to the North Carolina Center for  
6 Nursing Board of Directors for a term to expire on June 30, 1993. Lee Pridgen of  
7 Sampson County is appointed to the North Carolina Center for Nursing Board of  
8 Directors for a term to expire on June 30, 1992. This is the categorical appointment for  
9 a representative of the hospital industry.

10           Sec. 13. William Jordan Williamson, Jr., of Watauga County is appointed to  
11 the North Carolina Travel and Tourism Board for a term to expire on December 31,  
12 1992. This is the categorical appointment for a public member interested in matters  
13 relating to travel and tourism. Ralph Peters of Mecklenburg County is appointed to the  
14 North Carolina Travel and Tourism Board for a term to expire on December 31, 1992.  
15 This is the categorical appointment for a public member associated with the tourism-  
16 related transportation industry. Senator Beverly Perdue of Craven County and Senator  
17 Howard Lee of Orange County are appointed to the North Carolina Travel and Tourism  
18 Board for terms to expire on December 31, 1992.

19           Sec. 14. Unless otherwise provided, appointments made by this act shall  
20 commence upon ratification.

21           Sec. 15. This act is effective upon ratification.
