2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "INJURY" FOR PURPOSES OF THE

- 3 WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1 G S 97-2(6) reads as rewritten:

5	Section 1. G.S. 97-2(6) reads as rewritten:
6	"(6) Injury. 'Injury and personal injury' shall mean only injury by accident
7	arising out of and in the course of the employment, and shall not
8	include a disease in any form, except where it results naturally and
9	unavoidably from the accident. With respect to back injuries and
10	injuries to extremities of the body, however, where injury to the back
11	or extremity arises out of and in the course of the employment and is
12	the direct result of a specific traumatic incident of the work assigned,
13	'injury by accident' shall be construed to include any disabling physical
14	injury to the back or extremity arising out of and causally related to
15	such incident. Injury shall include breakage or damage to eyeglasses,
16	hearing aids, dentures, or other prosthetic devices which function as
17	part of the body; provided, however, that eyeglasses and hearing aids
18	will not be replaced, repaired, or otherwise compensated for unless
19	injury to them is incidental to a compensable injury."
20	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
