A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSENT OF NEW HANOVER AND PENDER
COUNTIES WITH REGARD TO CERTAIN LAND ACQUISITIONS IN THOSE
COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 615 of the 1991 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Sec. 3. G.S. 153A-15(c) reads as rewritten:

“(c) This section applies to Anson, Ashe, Bertie, Bladen, Brunswick, Burke,
Buncombe, Caldwell, Caswell, Cleveland, Columbus, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth,
Franklin, Granville, Harnett, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Johnston, Lee, Madison,
Martin, Montgomery, New Hanover, Pender, Person, Rockingham, Rowan, Sampson,
Stokes, Swain, Transylvania, Union, Vance, Warren, and Wilkes Counties only.”

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
