A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF PLUMBING AND HEATING LICENSE NUMBERS. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. G.S. 87-21(e) reads as rewritten: 6 Posting License; License Number on Contracts, etc. - The current license "(e) 7 issued in accordance with the provisions of this Article shall be posted in the business 8 location of the licensee, and its number shall appear on all proposals or contracts and requests for permits issued by municipalities. The initial gualified licensee on a license 9 is the permanent possessor of the license number under which that license is issued, 10 except that a licensee, or the licensee's legal agent, personal representative, heirs or 11 assigns, may designate in writing to the Board a qualified licensee to whom the Board 12 13 shall assign the license number upon the payment of a ten dollars (\$10.00) assignment fee. Upon such assignment, the qualified licensee becomes the permanent possessor of 14 the assigned license number. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the license number may be 15 assigned only to a qualified licensee who has been employed by the initial licensee's 16 plumbing and heating company for at least 10 years or is a lineal relative, sibling, first 17 cousin, nephew, niece, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law of 18 the initial licensee. Each successive licensee to whom a license number is assigned 19 20 under this subsection may assign the license number in the same manner as provided in this subsection." 21 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 22
