1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT RECOMMENDED BY THE JUVENILE LAW STUDY COMMISSION TO
3 AMEND THE DEFINITION OF AN UNDISCIPLINED JUVENILE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 7A-517(28) reads as rewritten:

6 "(28) Undisciplined Juvenile. –

7 a. A juvenile less than 16 years of age who is unlawfully absent
8 from school; or who is regularly disobedient to his parent,
9 guardian, or custodian and beyond their disciplinary control; or
10 who is regularly found in places where it is unlawful for a
11 juvenile to be; or who has run away from ~~home~~ home; or

12 b. A juvenile more than 16 years of age and less than 18 years of
13 age who is beyond the disciplinary control of his parent,
14 guardian, or custodian."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to actions
16 arising on and after that date.
