A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the Commercial Leaking Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of \$600,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$600,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to implement the provisions of Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes. There is appropriated from the Noncommercial Leaking Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of \$600,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$600,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to implement the provisions of Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 1991.
