G.S. 1A-1, Rule 5(e) reads as rewritten: 6 Filing with the court defined. – The filing of pleadings and 7 "(e) (1) other papers with the court as required by these rules shall be made 8 by filing them with the clerk of the court, except that the judge may 9 permit the papers to be filed with him, in which event he shall note 10 thereon the filing date and forthwith transmit them to the office of 11 12 the clerk. Filing by telefacsimile transmission. – If, pursuant to G.S. 7A-34 and 13 <u>(2)</u> G.S. 7A-343, the Supreme Court and the Administrative Officer of the 14 Courts establish uniform rules, regulations, procedures and 15 specifications for the filing of pleadings or other court papers by 16 telefacsimile transmission, filing may be made by the transmission 17

when, in the manner, and to the extent provided therein."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
