A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ONE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SOUTHEAST  
2 INTERSTATE LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT  
3 COMMISSION FROM NORTH CAROLINA RESIDE IN A COUNTY IN WHICH  
4 THE REGIONAL DISPOSAL FACILITY IS SITED.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 104F-2 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 104F-2. Appointment of members to the Southeast Interstate Low-Level**  
9 **Radioactive Waste Management Commission.**

10 (a) The Governor shall appoint two members to the Southeast Interstate Low-  
11 Level Radioactive Waste Management Commission as established by Article IV of the  
12 compact. Members shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The Governor may  
13 appoint an alternate for each member who may serve at and for such time as each  
14 regular member shall designate and who shall have the same power and authority as the  
15 regular member when so serving. Each member and alternate shall possess technical or  
16 professional qualifications based on training and experience in the management or  
17 regulation of low-level radioactive waste sufficient to assure informed judgments when  
18 acting as a member of the Commission.

19 (b) Of the two members of the Southeast Interstate Low-Level Radioactive  
20 Waste Management Commission appointed by the Governor pursuant to this section,  
21 one member shall be a resident of a county in which the low-level radioactive waste  
22 disposal facility established pursuant to this Chapter and Chapter 104G of the General  
23 Statutes is located. A facility shall be considered to be located in a county upon the  
24 designation, pursuant to G.S. 104G-9(g), of a site within that county as the preferred

1 site, or as a part of a preferred site which is located in more than one county. The  
2 Governor shall make the initial appointment under this subsection within 30 days after  
3 the designation of a preferred site."

4           Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
