This act shall become effective upon ratification and shall expire on July 1, 7 1991.-ratification." 8 9 This act applies only to Brunswick, Caswell, Clay, Graham, Sec. 2. Henderson, Hyde, Johnston, Macon, Sampson, Stokes, and Tyrrell Counties. 10
